# **Course Selection**

### **Placement Assessments**

We are asking your child to take subject area placement assessments to be completed before June 21, 2021. These results will help determine a student's best course placement.

Math is the only required assessment. World language and History are available, if needed. Students do not need to study for these assessments. The short assessments are strictly designed to help us better understand what material students have had previously and help us place new students in the best course possible.
